ORGANIZATION OF THE CIVIL AIR PATROL

Section E, Paragraph 18a, Added. The Wing Commander has delegated the responsibility of appointing unit commanders to the local Group Commander.

Section E, Paragraph 18b, Added. The following positions are the minimum requirements for the Group staff and will be the sections reviewed during a Staff Assistance Visitation: Commander, Safety, Finance, Operations, Emergency Services, Inspector, Logistics, Admin/Personnel (these may be combined), Public Affairs, Plans & Programs, which will encompass Cadet Programs, Senior Development & Aerospace Education. Group Commanders may add additional staff officers as they see fit, ie Communications.

Section E, Paragraph 18c, Added It is expected that each Group Commander will appoint a Vice Commander with the concurrency of the Wing Commander or his designee.

Part III, Added

1. The Chief of Staff may appoint members to a position called Executive Assistant to assist in the coordination of staff functions within the Wing Staff. There is no limit to the slots available for this assignment and this slot may be used for an internship-type program.
2. All Directors/Primary Staff Officers are hereby permitted to recruit members to serve as Deputy Directors to assist with their job function, as well as coordination of their assigned staff officers.
