CADET PROGRAMS

CAPR 52-16, 1 April 2003, is supplemented as follows:

1. **Purpose.** The Cadet Honor Society (CHS) of the Florida Wing is to help cadets gain academic recognition and credit for educational and scholarship purpose.
2. **Authority.** All operating authority of the Florida Wing Cadet Honor Society shall be derived from the Wing Commander, the Director of Cadet Programs (DCP), or this supplement.
3. **Criteria.** Florida Wing Cadet Honor Society criteria shall be as follows:
 - a. Score a 90% or above per achievement or milestone, which will be the average of both Aerospace and Leadership tests for Achievements 2 through 7. Note that Achievement 1 and milestone tests will stand by themselves and only the leadership tests will be used for achievements 8 through 16. Aerospace Education tests for Achievements 8-16 are open book and will not be counted.
 - b. Maintain this average over a consecutive three-achievement/milestone span, with no time frame.
 - c. The score will be calculated based on the first attempt of the test.
 - d. The cadet will be a member in good standing.
4. **Awards and Decorations**
The following decorations will be awarded upon receipt of this honor.
 - a. Cadets that earn this honor will be eligible to wear a blue/yellow shoulder cord.
 - b. Once approved, the cadet will be given a corresponding number and the cadet's name will be added to the list of the other Cadet Honor Society cadets listed on the Florida Wing Cadet Programs website.
5. **Senior Member Advisors.** The unit commander of each echelon may designate a member of his/her staff as a point of contact for upholding the criteria. That individual must have the knowledge of the cadet program as well as the criteria.
6. **Submission Procedures.** The following are the procedures for submitting candidates.
 - a. The unit commander will send a letter of recommendation with the cadet's name, CAPSN, unit charter, and the list of achievements/milestones covered. Any other documentation can be attached if necessary.
