Wing Policy Letter

Subject: FLWG Discrimination Policy
Directed To: All FLWG Members

The Florida Wing policy with regards to discrimination will be adhered to in accordance with the provisions as set forth in CAPR 39-1.

This regulation states, in part: "...no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal assistance."

The regulation further states: "...no qualified handicapped person in the United States shall be on the basis of handicap be excluded from participation in, denied the benefit of, or otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity conducted by the federal government or receiving federal financial assistance."

The Florida Wing further defines discrimination as exclusion based upon race, color, national origin, handicap, gender, age, religion or life style.

Individual incidents and complaints regarding alleged discrimination or discriminatory practices will be promptly reported by Wing and Region Commanders directly to the Director, CAP Personnel at National Headquarters.

This policy supercedes Policy Letter: 02-01.
